They lived in Ellis County, Texas in 1890.

In 1910 they were back in Montague Co., TX. Bettie stated they had been married 34 years and had 9 children, 7 living.

His wife, Bettie applied for pension 11 Dec 1917 from TX.

He died Nov 11 1917 at Montague, Montague Co., TX per pension records.

He is listed as being buried in Salona Cemetery, Bowie, Montague Co., TX by the SUV. (I have verified that this is correct)

He is also listed as buried in: Ellis County by Texas Civil war listing and in Montague Cemetery (No military info). (They did live there for a while.)

He is also listed as being buried in Sunset Cemetery, Adams Co, IL, from Ellis Co. (Author's note-I suspect he died at Quincy after being in the hospital there, and was shipped back to Texas for burial. He was then

erroneously listed as being buried in Sunset.)
