He was taken prisoner while with the 16th INF and was mustered out as of date of July 15 65.

He is listed on the Jacksonville Civil War monument and the 1872 Morgan Co. History.

They are living next door to his parents, John, b. Germany, and and Martha, b. NY.

In 1900 he is listed as widowed and only Burnice is still at home.

He applied for pension September 21 1891 from MO.

He died 31 Dec 1926 in Bronaugh, Vernon Co. MO. and is buried in McKill Cemetery, Bronaugh.

Note that pension records list George E. and George, both of Co I. The application for George E is Dec 21 1907 or 1908 from IL and appears to be a duplicate. It was not approved. Xxneed is Sarah buried McKill. Does he have mil stone?
