In 1910 they were living in Galesburg, Knox Co., IL.

He applied for pension June 28 1880 and Mar 1 1907, no state listed, assumed to be IL. His wife, Mary G, applied for pension June 13 1918 from IL.

He was born 27 Mar 1843 and died May 23, 1918 in Galesburg, IL as reported by GAR Post 45, Galesburg, IL. He is buried in lot 3634b7, Lawn Division, Springdale Cemetery, Peoria per SUV
