Twin children died at birth and are buried in Jacksonville East Cemetery. William, Samuel, above, and John, above were brothers, the sons of Abraham and Catharine Jumper of Jefferson Co., IL.. He applied for pension 23 Apr 1874. He is on the Jefferson County Pensioners list for 1883 as having a wound in the left thigh and receiving \$8.00 per month.

He was born 1843 and died Nov 7 1921 or 1901. He is buried in Knob Prairie Cemetery, Waltonville, Blissville Twp, Jefferson Co., IL Margaret is also buried there. Xxsend death date there. Check death date
