He is listed as also serving in Co. E and HQ, 32nd IL INF as Asst. Surgeon as William H.H. King, alias Edward T. King in the early pension index, but the dates in the AGR do not bear this out. In the later pension index cards, William H.H is not listed as being in the 101st, being listed only for Co. E and HQ, 32nd IL INF. Edward is listed only for Co E, 101st IL INF and as a Hospital Steward for the 11th MO INF.

He is listed on the Jacksonville Civil War monument and the 1872 Morgan Co. History.

He lived in Dallas County, Texas in 1890.

He applied for pension July 15 1895,

Pension index card obviously have these two mixed up. In the Marion, Indiana Soldiers Home he is listed as serving in both the 101st and the 11th MO, He was admitted Jan 1900 and died Dec 18, 1864! He is listed in one place as being buried in #448, and in the grave listing as # 447. There is also a record for him at both Leavenworth Soldiers Home and Danville Soldiers home. All 3 list James King of Jacksonville as next of kin.
