In the 1880 census for Jacksonville, Hester and all the children except Laura plus Phillip, 9 and John, 7 were living in Jacksonville. (perhaps he has been admitted to the Quincy Veteran's Home and later transferred to the one at Danville. He is listed as a patient in Danville in 1910 census.)

He applied for pension Jan 14 1875, no state listed, assumed to be IL. His wife, Sue B. (no data found other than this) applied for pension August 27 1910 from Kentucky. His wife was living in Owensboro, Ky when he was in the Soldier's Home.

He died June 21 1910 at Danville, IL. He is buried in Row 11, Grave 1295 Danville Natl Cemetery
