A copy of his Military Discharge is filed in Morgan Co. Courthouse.
In 1860 he was living with his parents, Michael and Susan, in Jacksonville.

He applied for a pension Oct 30 1865, no state listed, assumed to be IL. His wife Amelia, applied for pension September 19 1876, no state listed.
He was born in 1843, died in 1875, buried in Diamond Grove Cemetery, Jacksonville, Morgan Co., IL His wife is also buried there
