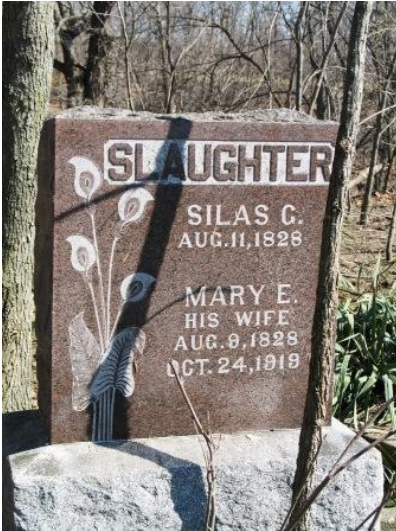
He is listed on the Jacksonville Civil War monument and the 1872 Morgan Co. History.

In the 1880 census, their niece, Lillie Ray, 7, was living with them.  
He applied for pension May 17 1865, no state listed. His wife, Mary E., applied for pension Sept 29 1913 from IL  
Born 11 Aug 1828. He was admitted to the Soldier's Home in Quincy, IL on November 22, 1909, patient number 8884.  
His death was reported by the Quincy GAR as Aug 1913.  
Died 9 Aug 1913, at Quincy, IL, buried in Sooy Cemetery, Morgan Co., IL. His wife Mary E was admitted to Soldier's Home on June 20, 1909. She is also buried in Sooy Cemetery.
