Carinda stated they had been married 31 years, had 6 children, 6 living.

He applied for pension Sep 13 1866 no state listed, assumed to be IL.

He was born 15 Nov 1844, and was admitted to Soldier's Home in Quincy, IL on June 18, 1912, patient number 9805. He died 17 Aug 1914, buried in Bethel Cemetery, Murrayville, Morgan Co., IL. His wife, Clarinda is also buried there.
