He attended a GAR encampment in Springfield, MO and listed himself from Butler in May 1900.

He applied for pension 14 Aug 1879. In 1890 he was living in Butler, MO In the 1900 and 1910 census he is listed as a widower and is living with his daughter Alice Lindsey at Mt. Pleasant,, Bates Co., MO.

He died Oct 6 1917 at Butler, Bates Co., MO. He is buried in Oak Hill Cemetery, in Butler, Bates Co., MO
