In 1900 only William was still living with them. Elizabeth stated they had 9 children, 5 living.

He applied for pension Feb 7 1865, no state listed, assumed to be IL.

Listed in 1959 HR as buried in Jacksonville East , died 22 Aug 1927 (Incorrect date listing.)

He was born 24 Dec 1849.

He was reported by the Jacksonville GAR and the pension index card to have died Mar 25 1914.

He is buried in Diamond Grove cemetery, Jacksonville, Morgan Cc., IL His wife Elizabeth is also there.
